Dark Horse Rules:

Dark Horse Doubles is a tournament where you will be randomly paired with a doubles partner, which will not be revealed until the results of the tournament are posted.

Results will be posted and payouts made after scores and averages have been verified, within 30 days of the tournament.

Prizes will only be paid to the main entry not the randomly paired partner.

Partners will be drawn & recorded before the beginning of game 1 Minimum to enter the tournament will be your main entry of \$20, after the first entry you can add multiple entries (multiple random partners) for \$5 each, (examples: \$20 will be one entry/partner, \$25 will be 2 entries/partners, \$40 will be 5 entries/partners.

Handicap will be calculated at 90% of a 225 average.

Average used will be in order as follows and will require a minimum of 21 games:

- 1) 2023-2024 book average; If multiple leagues, the highest of all leagues will be used.
- 2) If no 2023-2024 average exists, the highest average of the past 3 years will be used.
- 3) If no book average is available a verifiable current average can be used.

A verifiable average would be one that can be verified by using either bowl.com, league secretary, a league's official website, or a standing sheet signed by the league secretary including contact information. If none of the above apply, an average of 225 will be used.

The tournament director reserves the right to re-rate any average as needed. The Tournament Director has the right to refuse or remove any bowler as needed.
